BAAG Media4Development photo-journalism competition

Entry requirements

1. An entry into this competition must be submitted by a photographer and journalist working in partnership. However, that partnership may be only for the purposes of this competition, rather than an existing or ongoing collaboration.

If an individual believes they have the professional experience and expertise in both photography and journalism, and has been published in recognised media outlets in both mediums, then an individual may apply without a partner.

2. Due to the nature of the prize, the competition is open only to professional photographers and journalists. You will need to provide evidence of your professional experience in your application.

3. The minimum age of both entrants is 25 years.

4. Entrants must be a resident of the UK or an EU member state from the time they submit their entry into the Competition to the time they are selected as a winner.

5. The journalist must be able to write in English, and the examples of work provided in their submission must be in English.

6. The photographer and journalist must have travelled to – in a professional capacity – at least one developing country each. Details of these must be provided in the entry. If the winning entrants have not completed a HEAT course (hostile environment awareness training) or similar, they must do so before travelling to Afghanistan and BAAG will pay for the course.

7. The photographer and journalist must be available to travel to Afghanistan in late November or early December – exact dates to be finalised with BAAG and competition partners, and is dependent on the security situation in Afghanistan.

8. The winning entrants must be able to submit to BAAG their final copy and photographs by 20th December 2015.
